Re: Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN) Notice

The federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN) requires us to notify employees and the State Dislocated Worker Unit when we have a reduction-in-force that results in WARN notifications.

The BAE Systems, Inc. reduction-in-force will occur at a job site located at 603 Barracks Rd Ewa Beach, HI 96706. This is a mass layoff that is expected to be permanent, and 54 individuals were sent notification. The expected date of separation for these employees is September 30, 2022. There are no applicable bumping rights and no union applicability. These employees consist of eight (8) SCA Crew Leaders, one (1) SHE Manager, one (1) Program Manager, one (1) SCA Equipment Mechanic, one (1) SCA Personnel Assistance, one (1) SCA plan Scheduler, two (2) Safety Inspectors, two (2) Scheduling Clerks, one (1) SCA Space Unit/Lock Key, one (1) SCA Stock Selector Clerks, three (3) SCA Supply Technicians, two (2) SCA Tractor Trailer Trucker Drivers, twenty-six (26) SCA Warehouse Specialist, one (1) Operations Supervisor, and three (3) Field Services Supervisors.
