
Re: Program Termination Notice

This is to inform you that Hawaii Homeless Healthcare Hui, a Hawaii nonprofit corporation ("H4"), an affiliate of Kalihi Palama Health Center, a Hawaii nonprofit corporation, will be terminating its Medical Respite Program, located at 431 Kuwili Street 2nd Floor Honolulu, Hawaii 96817 (the "Medical Respite Program"). The termination of the Medical Respite Program is anticipated to occur on or around September 5, 2025. The Medical Respite Program has approximately 23 employees, all of whom will be terminated on or about September 5, 2025, as a result of termination of the Medical Respite Program.

Although the circumstances of the termination of the Medical Respite Program may not constitute a "closing" within the meaning of the Dislocated Workers' Act, Chapter 394B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, in an abundance of caution, H4 is providing written notification of the transaction to all employees of H4 and is informing them of their potential right to a dislocated worker allowance under the Dislocated Workers' Act.
