Dear Director Butay:

Pursuant to Hawai'i Revised Statutes § 394B-9 and Hawai'i Administrative Rules § 12-506-7, I am writing to inform you that Zetton Inc., dba Camado Ramen Tavern, a Hawai'i corporation (the "Company") will be permanently closing its Camado Ramen Tavern restaurant located at 320 Lewers Street, Honolulu, Hawai'i 96815 (the "Restaurant Closure"). The Restaurant Closure is expected to occur on or about January 31, 2026.

In addition to the Camado Ramen Tavern restaurant, the Company owns 10 other Oahu restaurants, and currently employs a total of 314 employees, of which 14 employees are part of the Camado Ramen Tavern division/operations of the Company (collectively, "Camado Ramen Tavern Employees"). The Company will provide information to all Camado Ramen Tavern Employees regarding available shifts at other restaurant locations operated by the Company and will accommodate the transfer of Camado Ramen Tavern Employees who wish to fill those shifts if available.
