Hawaiian Airlines is reducing its workforce at its facilities located at the following addresses as a result of the merger with Alaska Air Group, Inc.:

Hawaiian Airlines Corporate Headquarters - 52 out of 825 employees affected
3375 Koapaka Street, Suite G-350
Honolulu, HI 96819

Hawaiian Air Cargo – Hangar – 4 out of 213 employees affected
277 Elliott Street
Honolulu, HI 96819

Honolulu International Airport - 1 out of 87 employees affected
300 Rodgers Blvd
Terminal Two
Honolulu, HI 96820

The Company's address for purposes of HRS § 394B is the Hawaiian Airlines Corporate Headquarters location. While we presently expect these reductions to be permanent, the entire facility is not being closed.

Consistent with these plans, employment separations are expected to begin on or about December 31, 2024. Approximately 1125 non-contract employees work at the affected facilities, and approximately 57 of them are anticipated to be separated from employment.

None of the affected employees are represented by a labor organization. Bumping rights are not available for affected employees.
