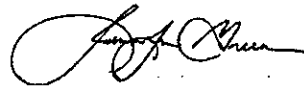
Due to unforeseeable business circumstances caused by the sudden outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic and the devastating impact that it is having on our Company and its customers, Flying Food Group, LLC will be permanently laying off 34 employees employed at our Kailua-Kona facility on April 17, 2020. 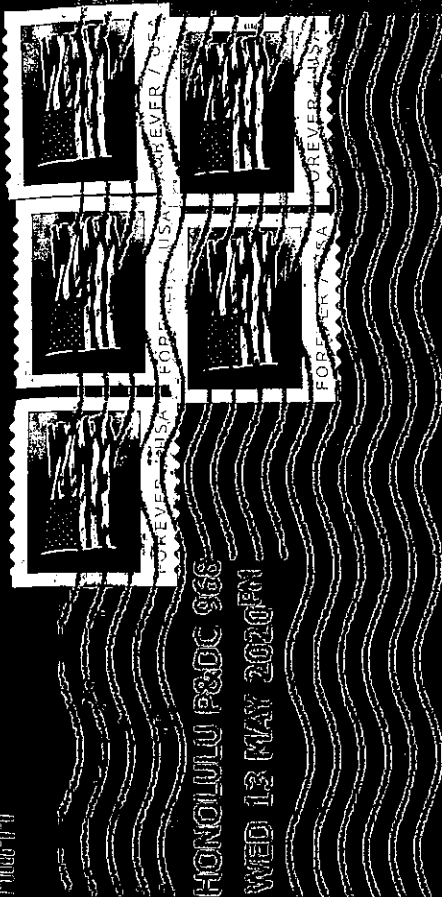
