Dear Michelle,

This notice is being provided to you pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act which requires employers to give official notice of a mass layoff, closure or functional elimination within a single site location. This is an update to the notice previously sent to you on June 16, 2020. T-Mobile is eliminating (27) additional positions at our 3375 Koapaka Street Ste G300 and 745 Fort St 20th Fl Honolulu, HI location. We are providing you a list of affected positions of employees notified through July 1, 2020.

These layoffs will be permanent, meaning there will be no right of recall, and T-Mobile does not have a “bumping” policy. None of the affected employees are represented by a union.

We hope to accomplish this with the least possible disruption to the lives of our employees and the community. Affected employees have been notified of the layoff by management and a letter. A list of the affected positions is attached.
